Surf Up - Riding the waves with Reveries:

In Laamu we have 2 breaks offering both left and right handers approximately 50 minutes north. Machine is a perfect Right-Hander with 3 barreling sections in larger swells but a fun ride in smaller swells. Machine Left is built for speed-demons while Refugee's Lefts and Rights are also close by for specific swell directions. Further south is the renowned YinYang break with thick barrels as well as easier outside sections.

All the surf points are located between 50 minutes to 2 hours boat trip from Reveries Scuba Zone.

Reveries Scuba Zone is running daily trips, leaving early each morning and returning at the end of the afternoon, giving you

an entire day of surfing, as well as lunch on a local island. Our surfing guide will be on hand to explain the patterns and give tips on the different conditions and best take-off zones.

These breaks were only reachable by Safari boat or expensive resort trips. Now Reveries Scuba Zone gives you access to some of the Maldives' most remote and pristine waves.



Diving in Laamu – Take a walk in the Underwater Sanctuary with Reveries:

Laamu's ring reef is unusual for having a small number of kandu, which reduces currents and can increase visibility up to 30m. This makes the wide variety of marine animals easier to spot, and to photograph - even for less experienced divers.

Reveries' guests are uniquely placed to experience life in the heart of the Maldivian atolls as very few have before. Rivalling the treasures to be found above sea level, Reveries is also the gateway to the precious underwater kingdom making up 99% of the archipelago. Our on-site dive center "Reveries Scuba Zone" will guide you through the wondrous coral reefs and exotic marine life which continue to support this unique nation.



More penetrating sunlight allows corals to grow at greater depths, and seems to have better protected them against recent bleaching events. From the shallow lagoon floor, which reaches a depth of up to 80ft, the ocean channels lead out to the reef slopes and down to a sandy terrace 115ft below, before falling away quickly to depths of over 2000ft. Around a dozen dive sites in Laamu are easily accessible with Reveries' own dive dhoni (Boat Ferry), offering a range of experiences. Channel dives give the chance to see a wide variety of pelagic species, including sharks, while further inside the lagoon awaits a Maldivian specialty, the coral pinnacles known locally as thila or haa, which attract schooling fish and soft corals. Mantas and turtles are a regular sight in the Maldives, while the proximity to deep water means occasional sightings of thresher sharks, hammerheads, and maybe even the mysterious mola mola, or Ocean Sunfish.
