RAINFOREST AWAKENING



As morning light breaks, the forest awakens to the sights and sounds of birds, monkeys, squirrels, and other delightful animals. The morning is one of the best times to walk our grounds to gain insight into the thriving plant and animal life here.



EXTENDED SUNGAI TRAIL



This extended route adds an additional 3 km beyond the standard Sungai Trail, taking you deep into the untouched corners of The Datai Langkawi's ancient rainforest. The trail follows a winding stream before climbing rugged terrain with steep slopes and exposed roots. Experience the raw beauty of Langkawi's lowland dipterocarp forest, where towering hardwoods and elusive wildlife await the quiet observer

Langkawi's location 6 degrees North of the equator allows us to see stars from both hemispheres, depending on the time of year. 




FISH FOR THE FUTURE
