

WHAT TO PACK

Here at Kandima, we're lucky with warm tropical weather all year round and temperatures ranging between 28 - 32 degrees. We're also a very laid-back, kool resort so you won't need formal outfits - just relax and be yourself!

- Snorkelling Kit (or you can hire it when you're here from Aquaholics. It's free of charge for our All Inclusive guests!)

IMPORTANT TO KNOW!

WHAT NOT TO PACK

- Alcohol: The Maldives is a Muslim country and alcohol is forbidden. Resorts in the Maldives are able to sell alcohol because they have a licence, but individuals can't be in possession of it. Therefore please do not bring any alcohol into the country upon arrival or take alcohol from the resort when you leave Kandima.
- Drones: We think drones are super kool, BUT we have many open-air bathrooms, swirl pools, swimming pools and places on the island where guests want total privacy. Having a drone flying above them whilst they're on holiday isn't the most relaxing experience as we're sure everyone agrees! For these reasons, we're a NO DRONE ZONE! But fear not! If you're putting a Kandima video together and want some drone footage to add, let an HQ buddy know when you arrive and we can sort that out for you.

Arriving at Velana Int. in Male'

The first thing to do when you walk out of those arrival doors is to look out for our Kandima Airport buddy or make your way to our Kandima counter No. D6!!

They'll then put you on your seaplane or domestic transfer to Kandima as soon as possible ready for your tropical island holiday!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Although transfers from Male' to Kandima are booked through Kandima Maldives, the seaplane and domestic airline are third-party companies. It is however, mandatory to book your transfer to Kandima through our Reservations Krew! We forward your international flight details onto them and it's their job to provide the best possible connecting flight for our guests, catering for hundreds of clients per day.

Unlike normal flights, these airlines do not issue tickets for customers before travel. But this isn't at all an issue! You will be shown to the check-in desk by our Kandima Airport Buddy as soon as you arrive and will then be issued your boarding pass!

Please also be aware that seaplane transfers are scheduled only one day prior to arrival so we will not be able to provide you with timings until the day before.

Your main job? To look out for our kool Airport Buddy when you walk out of the arrival doors at the airport OR make your way to our Kandima counter which is No. 65!

Oh-so kool FAQ's

Which currency is accepted in the resort?

Here at Kandima, we use USD (American Dollars) so you can bring these along with you. Most people pay their bill using their credit card. We also accept Visa, American Express and MasterCard. Due to the current regulations by The Maldives Monetary Authority (MMA), we're unable to accept the US Dollar banknotes that are older than the 2003-2008 series. Thus, at Kandima Maldives we will be accepting the US Dollar banknotes from the 2009 and above series only.

What's the dress code at Kandima and in the restaurants?

Kandima is a lifestyle resort and very casual but of course, it's also oh-so stylish! In the day, the dress code is beach casual in our restaurants, BUT bikinis and swim shorts aren't permitted. You must cover up when in the restaurants out of respect for all guests. In the evening, our dress code is smart casual. There are no rules on the type of shoes you must wear – all shoes, flipflops and heels are welcomed!

What type of sockets are in the villas?

We use British sockets throughout the resort (Type G British BS-1363). There is also one universal multi plug socket and two USB ports in your studio/villa/suite but if you need additional adaptor, just call the Buddy Centre.

What are the medical facilities like at Kandima?

We're extremely lucky at Kandima Maldives to have a brand new, large and fully kitted Medical Klinic. We also have our own dentist and a decompression chamber. Our European doctors are extremely experienced, with most of them coming from Germany.

How many languages are spoken at Kandima?

Our Kandima buddies are from all over the world so we speak many different languages, including English, Mandarin, Hokkien,

Russian, Arabic, French, Hindi, Thai, Italian & German!

Can we get snorkelling equipment when we arrive?

Of course! Our kool watersports centre Aquaholics has all the snorkelling equipment you need. We provide complimentary rental of snorkelling equipment for our snorkelling trips to the housereef. However, if you would like to rent the snorkelling gear throughout your stay, then there's a charge of \$9++ per person per day. If you're on the All Inclusive package, then it's free of charge. If you have your own snorkelling gear then why not pop it in your suitcase and bring it with you!
