- 1635 Special preparations for the Bride will take place at the Spa (See prices on page 3)
- *Makeup and Hairstyling*
- 1735 The Groom is chauffeured to Sangu Bar to await the Bride
- 1735 The Bride is ready and prepares to leave the Spa for Sangu Bar. The two meet.
- *Traditional Boduberu – Maldivian Drums will announce the couple's arrival*
- *The bride is presented a floral bouquet by a Maldivian Brides Maid.*
- *For the bridal march, Kuredu's official bridal entourage will stand on each side of the aisle holding palm leaves, which they lift row by row, as the couple passes.*
- 1800-1830 After the couple exchanges vows in the presence of an appointed the Master of Ceremony; the celebration begins
- 1830 Some time for the couples to walk the length of sandbank and island, then they can enjoy some tender moments along the sand bank before taking memorable pictures with the sunset.
- 1930 The couple returns to their villa.

We have come to do all of those things both old and new that are appropriate to just such an occasion. To say solemn words, to confirm a covenant, to recognize in this event the place of family, friends, and the larger human community. To laugh and to cry, to sing and to feast and to dance but above all to celebrate love and all of its possibilities.

..... and, come now and really be together to make your vows. You have known each other for some time now, and through the first glance of acquaintance through this moment of commitment, at some moment along the way you decided to marry. From that moment of "yes" through this moment of "yes", indeed, you have already been making promises in an informal way. All those conversations that you held riding in a car, or over a meal, or on a long walk, all those sentences that began "When we are married," and continued with "I will if you will" and "we will."
