




ETERNAL BLISS



Symbolically used to represent totality, a circular floral arch with a cascade of colorful flowers is an unforgettable backdrop for you to become bonded for eternity.







RECEPTION

- 1 Projector and screen for a slideshow of memories

























For the wedding, our bridal bouquet and bridesmaid bouquets consist of timeless white roses, accompanied by small white flowers and wrapped in green foliage.

Should you wish to have another color palette or different types of flowers, it will be subject to seasonality and extra charge.






