Krabi Overview

1. Krabi is a traditional Thai town, much less developed and less commercial than its sister resorts of Phuket, Pattaya, and Koh Samui.
2. Some 154 islands lie off the coast of Krabi, most of which are uninhabited, except by monkeys, monitor lizards and aquatic birds. These limestone karst towers stand as monuments to natural evolution and are one of Thailand's most recognizable and photogenic images.
3. Adventure! Thanks to its landscape, Krabi is home to numerous outdoor activities, chief among them rock climbing, where the sheer cliffs are world famous for daunting and exciting sport. Also popular are mountain biking trails and tours, kayaking through mangrove forests, and whitewater rafting.
4. Sunsets. Krabi and its surrounding beaches face west over the Andaman Sea into the sunset. If you were ever looking for that tropical Instagram image of yourself, cocktail in hand, sitting under palm trees on a white-sand beach, gazing out longingly as the sun burns over the horizon – this is it!
5. Krabi is the cultural crossroads for the peoples of two religions – Muslims and Buddhists. Mosques sit alongside Buddhist temples while monks meditate and walk the streets for their morning alms as the local Mullah calls devotees to prayer. Few towns in the world can boast of such a harmonious meeting of cultures.

6. The meeting of Malay Muslims and Buddhist Siamese also gave rise for a unique cuisine culture, famed throughout Thailand. Krabi cuisine employs a variety of herbs and spices, and specializes in seafood, most notably oysters. Visitors will also adore the selection of tropical fruit such as durian, pomegranate, mango, jackfruit, oranges, and pineapple.

7. Krabi is a great place to source local products and souvenirs, especially batik cloths and pearls from the deep sea. Ask around and you'll find shops and stalls offering unique batik designs and pearl earrings, wonderful presents to take home.

8. It is easier and cheaper to fly to Krabi. From Bangkok, it's just a one-hour flight, and you'll find Krabi Airport is small and quickly efficient, without the hordes of tourists and queues you'll find elsewhere. Not only that, internal flights to Krabi are half the price you'd pay to go to Koh Samui. From Bangkok, prices start at just US\$30 one way! Nowadays, several international airlines fly directly to and from Krabi. You can catch a direct flight from Malaysia, Singapore, several cities in China, Myanmar, Scandinavia, and Qatar.

9. If you are traveling to Thailand in Feb/March you shouldn't miss the Naga Festival, which is one of the most exciting and fun gatherings of the year. The highlight is arguably the Jazz Festival, which draws Jazz aficionados from all over the globe.

10. The Naga. The "naga" is a serpentine creature from Hindu mythology which has long been adopted by the people of Krabi into local beliefs and superstitions. Visitors will come across naga amulets for good luck, jewelry and souvenirs, as well as many depictions of the semi-dragon, semi-snake around the art galleries of the town. It is also worth mentioning that Banyan Tree Krabi sits at the foot of Naga Crest Hill, so called for its undulating landscape, similar to a slithering dragon. The naga theme is also evident throughout the resort in its design features.

11. Travel Bubble. In these days of Covid Awareness, the Thai government has selected Krabi as one of five preferential destinations for travelers to visit from 2020–21. This is because: (a) it lies far from major population centers; (b) it has gratefully remained relatively free of C-19 to date; and (c) authorities are confident that all precautions are being taken in Krabi and its hotels to ensure the safest possible environment.

Khao Ngon Nak Trail

Dragon Crest Mountain or Khao Ngon Nak (Thai) is a mountain which is 565 meters tall from the sea level. The path from foothill to hilltop is around 3700 meters. To reach to the top, it may require a few hours and you have to face health and physical challenge but the stunning view can be a reward of experience. The path was surrounded by the trees and rocks. From the hilltop, you can see all Ao Nang beach and it is a good spot to watch sunrise and sunset.

Sightseeing at Koh Hong

Ko Hong or known as Ko Lao Bi Le. Situated in the Than Bok Khorani national park, the islet has a world-class breathtaking landscape, which is categorised as one of the world's top ten attractions with Amazing clean Beaches. It is surrounded by indigo Sea with soft powder-like sandy beach and good for visitors who enjoy nature, swimming and snorkeling.

Visiting and Karst Rock Climbing at Railey Beach

Railey Beach is a stunning and peaceful Beach comprising 3 coastlines featuring on the west side Railey Beach, the east side Railey Beach and am Phra Nang. Giant pillars of karst limestone protrude into the sky around Railey Beach, home to some of the best rock climbing in the world.

Thale Waek Excursion (Separated Sea Excursion)

Thale Waek is a renowned natural attraction of Krabi and named one of the "Unseen Thailand" resulting from the natural wonder when the tide recedes. If you plan to do a day trip to Thale Waek, you can enjoy swimming, snorkeling and sunbathing at the 4 island hopping, Visit Chicken Island, Tup Island, Poda Island and Phra Nang Cave.

Ao Thalane Mangrove Kayaking

Ao Thalane is a small fishing village in the heart of native Krabi and is one of the most beautiful bays in the area. It is one of the most popular location for kayaking. It is beautiful and splendid area with abundant mangrove forests, limestone mountains, caves, lagoons and canyons. Ao Thalane is suitable for exploration by all ages.

Khao Khanab Nam

The Khao Khanab Nam Mountains are known as one of Krabi's most famous landmarks. With limestone cliffs on one side, sparkling shores on the other, peppered with nature and cultural attractions every which way. These mountains are nature's very own gateways to Krabi city, and the river that runs between the two limestone cliffs forms a beautiful photograph.

Tub Kaek Sunset

Tub Kaek is a long peaceful sandy beach which makes this an ideal place to relax and recharge your batteries. Admittedly it is beautiful by day, but it becomes a thing of wonder in the evenings. It offers a dramatic sunset with silhouette of islands over Andaman sea. Kredkaew Bar at Banyan Tree Krabi is one of the best spots to view Tub Kaek Sunset.

Ban Ko Klang Community

Ban Ko Klang Community is a charming community situated on a tiny island that preserves the simple lifestyle and its own identity. It is surrounded with abundant mangrove forest of more than 1,000 rai at the estuary. Most of the villagers are Muslims. There are many interesting community-based attractions; such as the organic farming, patch cloth, etc.

Morning Market at Maharaj

Established in 2003, Maharaj Market in Krabi offers a fantastic range of locally produced ingredients and cooked foods. Maharaj Market is a morning market and open from 03:00 until around 10:00 by which time nearly all the traders would have packed up for the day. Maharaj Market is a cultural experience and a daily celebration of the things local farmers grow.

Wat Kaew Korawaram

This temple is also known simply as Wat Kaew, is the largest Buddhist temple within Krabi Town and one of most prestigious in the entire region. The majestic staircase leading to the 2,500sqm terrace on which the temple stands, is lined with magnificent statues of Naga, the fascinating Hindu deity with the body of a serpent and nowadays hosts The Krabi Contemporary Art Museum.

Wat Tham Suea

The Tiger Cave Temple is a Buddhist temple northeast of Krabi. One of the most sacred Buddhist sites in the province, it is well known for the tiger paw prints in the cave, tall Buddha statues and the strenuous flight of stairs to reach the summit. It is 1237 steps to reach the top to see the great view of Krabi.

Sra Morakot

Sra Morakot or Emerald Pool, located at Khao Pra-Bang Khra Wildlife Sanctuary, features a large circular emerald-like pool with a small cascade flowing and is swimmable. When visitors walk to the headwater, they will reach Bo Nam Phut, a wonderful ultramarine coloured pool.

Namphu Ron Khem and Namtok Ron Khlong Thom

Namphu Ron Khem Khlong Thom is the only salted hot spring in Thailand. There are 14 natural hot springs emerging from under the ground widespread in the area that is rich with many minerals, which benefits the blood circulation system of the body. It is ideal for people who love mineral bathing, waterfall.

Wat Bang Thong

Wat Bang Thong is complex of temples in Northern Krabi. The newest addition and most probably the most impressive is Wat Maha That Wachiramongkol, which is a golden pagoda standing over 100 meters tall. Inside the temple, there are the stunning artwork lining the walls, the animals of the Thai lunar calendar dotted around as well as many Buddha statues.

Andaman Cultural Study Center

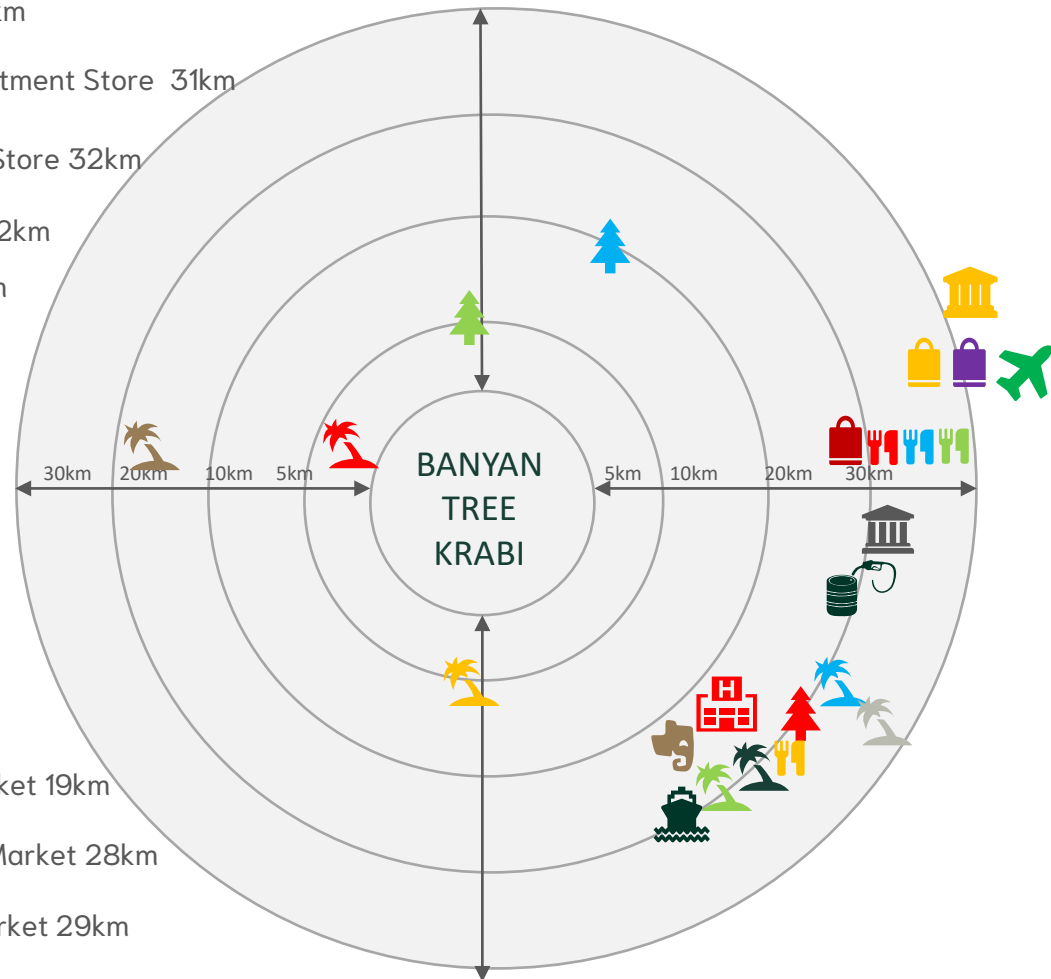
