



Deira at a glance



Deira's historic significance and continued development has ensured the area remains one of the most densely populated districts in Dubai. Deira features extensive transport infrastructure, numerous established businesses, and a vast number of retail and F&B options, with traditional businesses including gold, textiles, spices, carpets, and more.

Deira is one of the oldest and most established areas in Dubai. The area was originally the only commercial district of the emirate, prior to the development of Bur Dubai, Sheikh Zayed Road, and more recent developments. Deira's continued expansion has resulted in numerous provisions for residents, ranging from residential units, commercial spaces, retail outlets, as well as hospitality options.



Traditional Spice Market

Your senses will come alive at the Dubai Spice Souk. Located in the heart of Deira, adjacent to the Dubai Gold Souk, this small covered market is home to more than 150 small retailers. In front of shops, you'll find staple spices as well as more usual offerings, such as orange peel, dried cucumber, and authentic saffron alongside dried fruit, nuts, basmati rice, incense burners, henna kits; shipped daily from India, Pakistan, and Iran.



The Gold Souk

Your trip to Dubai is not complete without a stop at the famed Gold Souk, one of the oldest and most charming traditional markets in the emirate. Located in the commercial business district in Deira, in the locality of Al Dhagaya, the souk consists of over 380 retailers, most of whom are jewelry traders. Whether you are just browsing or on the hunt for a rare piece, the glittering Gold Souk will leave you in awe.



The Dubai Creek

The Dubai Creek is a saltwater creek. Previously, it extended to Ras Al Khor Wildlife Sanctuary, but as part of the new Dubai canal, it flows through to the Persian Gulf. The creek lies between two districts Deira and Bur Dubai, both of which have been the foundation of Dubai's transformation into the megacity it is today. A commercial hub and home to residential activity in the city over the years, the creek is one of the leading tourist destinations in the city, underlining the rich culture and legacy of Dubai.



Shindagha Heritage Village / Historic District

The Heritage Village was created in 1997 in Al Shindagha Historical Neighborhood in Dubai, close to the Diving Village, to embrace the heritage events and to display a live image of the old traditional life in UAE. It represents the components of wild, marine, and mountain life, where the visitor can connect with the old traditional customs of the country and the unique characteristics of old houses, handicrafts, patterns, and forms of living.
